Forty-seven years after the last French retrospective exhibition on Paul Klee given by the Musée national d'art moderne in 1969, the Centre Pompidou crosses through the artist's work again. What with its 250 works of art – coming from the most important international collections such as Zentrum Paul Klee or private collections – this thematic retrospective offers an original take on this unusual figure of modernity and of the art of the twentieth-century.

#### Le Douanier Rousseau. Archaic innocence Musée d'Orsay – To 17 July

An extremely unusual painter, Henri Rousseau is a unique figure in the history of European art. His work is, however, in keeping with his time, the dawn of the 20th century: the exhibition compares his painting with several of his sources of inspiration, which included both academic painting and new painting, and with the avant-garde artists who enthroned him as the father of modernity, The Douanier Rousseau.
